### **PSP2600: Atari 2600 emulator for PSP v1.0.5 \*SLIM\***

Hi All,

For those who has missed the beginning, Stella is on of the best emulator of Atari 2600 game console, running on many different systems, such as Linux, Solaris, Windows, MacOS/X, WinCE, OS/2, GP2X.

It has been written initially by Bradford Mott, see Stella site for details.

PSP2600 is a port on PSP of the version v2.2 of Stella. It's based on the work of Aenea who was the first to port Stella to PSP, and David Voswinkel who's now in charge of the PSP port in Stella team.

It has been developped on linux for Firmware 3.x-OE and for PSP-slim.

What's new in this version ?

- Compatible with custom firmwares 3.x and PSP-slim
- Add a simple intro splash screen
- Support iso8859-1 fonts in print text functions  
(might be useful to translate psp2600 menus in german, french ...)
- Bug fix in file requester

How to use it ? Everything is in the README.txt file.

Sources are included, and this package is under the GNU public license, read COPYING.txt file for more information about it.

Hello - I apologize for being repetitive - But I just noticed this version for fw3.X - I installed it and it also does not seem to support ZIP files - I also updated to the latest version of PSP7800 for fw3.x and this one works fine with zip files... Also, I noticed that ALL of the emulators out there (including yours) are working with my NON-SLIM M33's 3.52-OE-4 firmware... I find that labeling these wonderful emulators as "SLIM" can be misleading and deter many to not upgrade if they dont have a SLIM... THANK YOU FOR YOU WONDERFUL EMULATORS!!
